GENERAL TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Terroir:

The vineyard of Château Haut-Mayne grows on the gravel plots left bank of the Garonne River, 35 km South of Bordeaux.

Rounded and polished gravel is found on the surface. The substratum is calcareous and sandy soils unite the whole.

Size of the vineyard : 15 ha

A high planting density : 5500 vines/hectare.

Average age of the vines : 35 years

Production:

Average yield : 50hl / ha

Volume : 2000 bottles

Vinification and maceration :

- Cold pre-fermentation Maceration.
- Juices ferment in stainless steel tanks.
- Merlot is aged in French oak barrels, 12 months

TECHNICAL FEATURES OF THE 2017 VINTAGE

Harvest : from September 25th

Final alcohol content : 13,0 % alc. by volume

Blending 2017:

10% Cabernet Sauvignon ; 90% Merlot

Tasting notes:

Slightly mature garnet. Delicate nose of morello cherry, strawberry and violet. The palate is supple and showcases fairly ripe fruit. Well-balanced and crunchy with polished tannins. The finish is quite upright and needs a little more bottle time
