Story

Domaine de La Ville Rouge is located right in the heart of Crozes Hermitage. It was founded by Paul Girard in 1919.

Originally, the vineyard had only a few hectares of vines, and the harvest was purchased by the cooperative cellar.

In 2005, Sébastien and his parents decided to build their own cellar and since 2006, the vinification and bottling is done at the estate.

Today Domaine de la Ville Rouge is driven in organic farming (certified by ECOCERT) and biodynamic (certified by BIODYVIN), by Sébastien and Audrey his wife. It now represents 20 hectares.

Wine description

With a gold colour, the wine seduces from its nice balance between richness, flowers, and peach notes. Perfect as aperitif, it will beautifully match with fish in cream sauce, duck foie gras, spicy and salty dishes and strong cheeses
